¡Sí Cuba!* is a collaborative venture between museums, universities, galleries, and other arts organizations across New Orleans.** Organized by the **Newcomb Art Gallery at Tulane University** and the **New Orleans Museum of Art**, the project is anchored by ***Polaridad Complementaria: Recent Works From Cuba, a joint exhibition opening at both venues on January 16.

The show was developed by the Centro de Arte Contemporáneo Wifredo Lam, Havana, in collaboration with the City of Charleston Office of Cultural Affairs and is toured by International Arts & Artists, Washington, DC.
