Margarita Jover is an Architect and Urban designer by ETSAV-UPC (Polytechnic University of Catalonia), in Barcelona, Spain. She co-founded in 1996 the internationally awarded firm 'aldayjover architecture and landscape'. The work is particularly renowned by its leadership in a new approach to the relation between cities and rivers as well as for the urban and civic integration of 'hybrid infrastructures'.

aldayjover architecture and landscape has been awarded with several prizes for built work amongst which the 'European Urban Public Space Prize' in 2002, the 'FAD Prize City and Landscape' in 2009, the 'International Association of Public Transportation Award' (UITP) in 2012 and the 'Architect's Association of Aragon prize', Spain, in 2001 and 2005.

Margarita Jover is 'Professor of Practice' at the School of Architecture at the University of Virginia. Previously she had been guest-professor at the ESARQ-Barcelona 2001, Lecturer at the UPC-Master "Housing Laboratory of the XXI century" 2004-2009 Barcelona, visiting at the Urbanism Department of the UPC-ETSAV 2002-2004, and 'Associate Professor' at BAU-School of design 1998-2009 as well as member of several Juries in international competitions.
